

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position Title: Volunteer Carpenter

PURPOSE: Aid the mission of Old World Wisconsin through the maintenance, fabrication and repair of both historic and non-historic items

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain and repair a range of wooden objects on-site ranging from fencing to windows under the direction of the Maintenance Coordinator
- Assist with site prep in spring and site clean-up at end of season.
- Help keep maintenance building clean and organized.
- Assist with maintenance related activities for/at special events.
- Willingness to assist with special requests from Maintenance Coordinator.
- Adhere to all COVID related policies and procedures.

GOAL: To provide a safe and well-maintained environment for Old World Wisconsin’s guests

TIME COMMITMENT: April through October; at least 1 shift per month. Shifts typically last between 2 to 4 hours at a time and do not exceed 8 hours. Some winter projects may be available dependent on current needs of Old World Wisconsin.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ability to work in varying weather conditions. Appropriate use of tools while completing site work. Ability to/comfort with working on ladders when needed. Support the safe and responsible use of PPE in compliance with current State and Federal Guidelines.
